10-YEARS JUBILEE OF SWISS LAGOTTO CLUB
18 AND 19 JUNE 2005
REITHALLE HOLZIKEN

Almost 10 years ago, on 21 October 1995, in the presence of some 30 Lagotto Romagnolo owners, the Swiss Lagotto Club was founded. In the same year, the first Lagotti were born in our country, and ever since the interest for this exceptional breed has steadily grown. Today, the Swiss Lagotto Romagnolo population has reached almost 700 and our Club counts more than 350 members.

This seems to us a good reason to celebrate this jubilee! – **We are going to hold our Clubshow during the weekend of 18 and 19 June 2005 in the "Reithalle" (riding hall) of Holziken**, a small country village just a few miles south of Aarau (some 80 km distance of Berne and 50 km from Zürich).

A variety of activities are planned: on Saturday, 18 June, there will be a Championship Lagotto Romagnolo Show (CAC and CAC-Youth) followed in the late afternoon by a "seminario tecnico" for members of the *Unione Mondiale dei Club Lagotto Romagnolo (UMLAG)*. It is with pleasure that we can inform you that the President of UMLAG and the Lagotto Club of Italy (C.I.L.), Dr. Giovanni Morsiani, will be acting as both judge for the show and key speaker of the "seminario tecnico".

On Sunday, 19 June, the "less formal" part of the jubilee will take place. We plan to show to the visitors what the "Lagotto Romagnolo helveticus" is able to perform. There will first be a variety of demonstrations: obstacle and agility, the Lagotto Romagnolo as therapy and escort dog, and so on. Later on, all participants will be asked to take their own Lagotto on a – not too difficult – obstacle' course. However, there will remain plenty of time to look at various exhibition stands, to eat (the restaurant of the "Reithalle" will be open throughout the weekend) and to exchange their views and experiences with other Lagotto Romagnolo owners.

We, of course, hope that there will be an exceptionally high number of visitors and participants not only from the Swiss but also from other European Lagotto Romagnolo Clubs.
